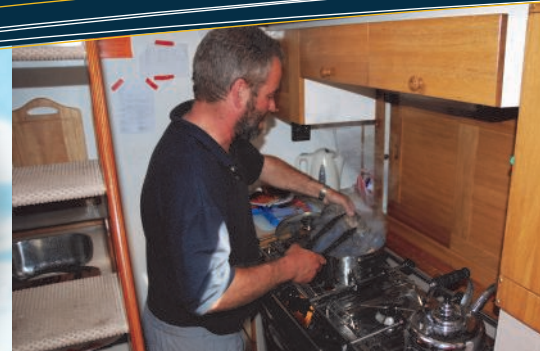

On board Tenacity of Bolton our aim is to provide visiting groups with quality experiences of coastal sailing. All our courses are tailor made to ensure that everyone benefits from the experience.



### Life on Board...

Sleeping accommodation on board is available for 10 guests in 3 separate cabins. With up to 12 people living on board, space is obviously at a premium - however, personal space is available for each guest in the form of a locker and their berth. Tenacity of Bolton also has modern conveniences found on board most modern yachts including heating, hot and cold water, shower and plenty of headroom!

### What to Expect...

Whilst groups are on board our ethos is that all members of the crew will be fully involved in all of the aspects of life on board. Don't be surprised to be taking your turn at the navigating and sail handling one minute and helping out with the catering, cleaning and maintenance of the boat the next minute, of course all of the time under the watchful eye of the skipper and mate.



### Safety First...

Whatever your aims you can be sure that your group will benefit from the expertise and individual care shown by the Skipper and First Mate.

We take no short cuts with safety and all of our voyages are designed with you in mind. If you have any special requirements we will do our utmost to accommodate them.

Upon arrival, groups will receive a full safety briefing in all aspects of the safety kit carried on board. Individuals are issued with personal foul weather gear and lifejackets.



Whether this is your first voyage on the sea or you are completing your 1,000th nautical mile you will be well looked after on board. Destinations on your voyage will be decided with you and your experience in mind, with of course a careful thought to the prevailing weather and tides. With Glasson Dock, Lancaster as her home port there are many local ports and anchorages to discover around Morecambe Bay but Tenacity of Bolton is by no means confined to the local area. Voyages with a willing crew can travel West across to the Isle of Man and on to Ireland or North up into the Clyde and beyond or South to North Wales and Anglesey, let your imagination run wild!



### THE BUILDING OF 'TENACITY OF BOLTON'

Designed as a celebration of the new millennium, the 'Third Millennium Ketch' as she was then known, was built using the enthusiasm and manpower of the boys of Bolton School Boys' Division. The first frames were made in 1998 and over the

next 9 years time was spent during lessons and in lunchtime clubs gradually piecing together all the elements that make up 'Tenacity of Bolton'. Built from ferro cement she is a one off - purpose designed and built to suit the requirements of Bolton School and now also available to Charter by groups. She is coded by the MCA to work in category 2 waters and is

able to take a crew of 10 who are overseen by the boat's professional crew of Skipper and 1st Mate. Weighing in at 24 tonnes and nearly 60 foot in length she is no lightweight modern cruiser but still boasts all the modern conveniences expected on today's cruising yachts and also has comfortable sea performance.
